Failure to complete any part of this application may weigh adversely on the final decision. All information will be kept strictly confidential by the selection committee. Applicant must: 1. Submit a letter of application detailing the areas of volunteer service, including organizations served, time committed, duties and projects, and supervisors. 2. Arrange for a letter of recommendation from each such organization to be submitted with the letter of application. 3. Be accepted into a baccalaureate degree program at an accredited post-secondary school. 4. Be a resident of the state of Maine or a descendant, nephew or niece of Paula Baillargeon. The scholarship will be awarded based on quality, quantity, and commitment to volunteer service without regard to age, gender, race, creed, or national origin. The scholarship does not have to be awarded if the committee determines that there are no candidates who exemplify the requisite spirit of volunteer service. Any amount not awarded or not claimed by December 31 will be forfeited and donated to Old Fort Western on the Kennebec. Please mail completed application to the address shown below.
